REGISTRATION WILL CLOSE ON MONDAY, JUNE 28, 2021

In order to provide the best experience possible, the camps only accommodate up to 25 students each, so register early! A minimum deposit of \$100 is required to reserve your spot. Students paying the full price with their application will be permanently placed on the camp list. Those who choose to pay only the deposit at the time of registration will need to pay the remaining balance by June 28, 2021, in order to ensure their place in camp. In the event of a student canceling his or her registration, Compass College of Cinematic Arts will retain a \$25.00 administration fee before reimbursing the remaining funds.
